Equitable & Inclusive Classrooms with Dynamic Curriculum

AIM- To ensure our school has structures and routines, a physical and social environment which ensures inclusive practice which will be supported by a Dynamic Curriculum.

How?

By using the Circle Resource to reflect on provision for learners and creating actions plans to address any areas for development. We will gather the Learner's Voice. Learners will share their views and ideas and we will act upon these. Each Term a different area will be evaluated in our Quality Improvement Programme. Learning across the curriculum will be planned using the Developing the Young Workforce and Education Scotland's Meta-Skills Toolkit.

Raising Attainment

AIM- For all targeted learners to develop skills and qualities that lead to raising attainment and achievement in Numeracy, Literacy and Health and Wellbeing.

How?- Results from the targeted children's summative and formative assessments will be used to plan interventions to ensure these pupils are making progress in their Learning. Pupil's with sensory needs will be supported through planned interventions and our Sensory Room resource. We will be running a Young Carers group to support the Young Carers that have identified within our school.

Attendance

AIM- To ensure targeted children maintain or increase their attendance.

How?- For families to have increased awareness of the importance of attendance. To survey the learners and families to ensure any barrier to attendance can be removed. Then plan interventions to address the removal of any barriers.

Care Experienced

AIM- To provide Nurturing Opportunities for our Care Experienced Children to ensure they can feel safe, healthy, active, nurture, achieve, respected, responsible and included.

How?- To use HWB questionnaire and Leuven Scale to identify the needs of the learner and interventions will be planned. The impact of these interventions will be monitored through the year.

Participatory Budget

Aim - Through consultation with all stakeholders, we aim to provide our learners with richer and wider experiences.

How? - Consultation with stakeholders then decisions made following a democratic vote.

Cost of the School Day

Aim - We are committed to ensuring that there are no financial barriers to learners attending school.

How?

We will consult with parents and carers as to how we can be proactive in minimising the cost of the school day.

Refer families to different organisations for support when needed.

Send out the Cost of the School Day Sway and calendar regularly throughout the year.
